Important Information Regarding EUC 2026

- Contestants are required to attend all scheduled events, in particular those marked with an asterisk (*). In exceptional circumstances, and upon prior request, the Contest Director may grant permission to miss a specified event.
- During registration, contestants must present a valid identification document and an official certificate of enrollment from their university.
- After registration, all participants are required to wear their badges at all times in a clearly visible manner.
- **Contestants are required to wear EUC 2026 T-shirts during the main contest on Sunday and during the Closing Ceremony.**
- Contestants must not bring any electronic devices into the contest hall, both during the dress rehearsal and during the main contest. Exceptions may be granted in justified cases only with the approval of the Contest Director.
- Access to the contest venue is possible only through Building B. A self-service cloakroom will be available for all participants, where all outerwear must be left. Bags, backpacks, and similar items are not allowed in the contest hall. Participants are strongly advised to leave valuable items at their hotel or in another secure location.
- No lunch is planned on the day of the main contest. However, during the contest a buffet with sandwiches, snacks, fruit, and hot and cold beverages will be available for contestants and other participants.
- The buffet will not be available during the dress rehearsal.
- Contestants are not allowed to bring their own food or drinks into the contest hall.
- Eating and drinking in the contest hall are strictly prohibited. Only solid sweets, such as chocolate bars or candy bars, are permitted.
- On Sunday, special rooms with Internet access and live contest monitoring will be available for on-site coaches and other team-affiliated registered persons. These are Rooms A207 and A221, located next to the auditorium in Building A.
- During the contest on Sunday, a computer lab (Room A312) on the third floor of Building A will also be available, allowing coaches to monitor their own teams.
- Championship participants will have Internet access either via Eduroam or via a dedicated network **EUC2026** with password **icpceuc2026!**
